Re: Arrest of Offender Caleb Edward Rogers

Probationer and parolee Caleb Edward Rogers is under arrest for probation violations and currently in custody at the Metropolitan Detention Center.

Wednesday evening February 22, 2012 Rogers came in to the Probation and Parole office in Albuquerque located on 111 Gold S.E. Rogers was suppose to show up that morning but claimed he was at work. Rogers was instructed to wait for an officer to give him a drug test. Rogers ran out of the office and fled in a vehicle.

A Probation and Parole officer contacted Albuquerque Police and the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office to report a warrant out for Rogers.

The next day, at 1:00 p.m., Rogers, his girlfriend, a child, a female and Rogers' brother were spotted by Albuquerque Police at Chevron gas station located at the intersection of San Mateo and Indian School. APD made contact with the offender and held him there to await transport.

When Probation and Parole officers arrived on the scene they were told by APD detectives that Rogers was in the middle of a wedding ceremony. Rogers' girlfriend claimed the group was on their way to a nearby park so that Rogers and she could be married.

Probation and Parole officers explained to APD detectives that any offender, including Rogers, is not allowed to enter into any civil contract without the consent or authorization of Probation and Parole.

After his arrest, Rogers admitted to using heroin that morning and prior to his February 22nd office check-in. He was given a drug test prior to being transported. If you have any questions call me.
