Re: Probationer Tyler East probationer Arrested

March 22, 2012

New Mexico Corrections Department probationer Tyler East is charged with aggravated burglary, aggravated battery upon a household member, and false imprisonment. East was arrested Sunday, March 18, 2012, by the Albuquerque Police Department. East is being held at the Metropolitan Detention Center for the new charges and pending a probation revocation hearing. Probation and Parole officers will be conducting an assessment to provide a recommendation to be considered by the court for sentencing.

Since his 2010 deferred sentence of 3 years probation for aggravated battery with a deadly weapon resulting in great bodily harm, East has had 3 probation violations, and has been attending counseling.

Summarized criminal history:

11/8/2011 Probation reinstated. The Defendant is placed back on probation with all the conditions of the original probation.

8/15/2011 Arrested for numerous Probation violations:

- 1) Received new charges: Harassment
- 2) Was found to be in possession of a State of New Mexico Identification card with his picture but his brother's information including the name, Cody East, date of birth, height, weight and eye color
- 3) Being outside of Valencia County without a travel permit
- 4) Testing positive for cocaine
- 5) Admitted to drinking alcohol
- 6) For associating with his ex-girlfriend and children who were the victims in the child endangerment case that was dismissed

1/28/2011 Probation Violation for violating the terms of his probation by incurring new charges of child endangerment and by having weapons in his possession

6/21/2010 Deferred Sentence and 3 years probation for aggravated battery with a deadly weapon resulting in great bodily harm. A special condition of East's probation listed within the judgment and sentence is that the Defendant shall be allowed to continue his mixed martial arts career, training locally and traveling within New Mexico and outside of New Mexico for scheduled bouts.
