To provide for the adoption of rules to manage all operations and to administer and enforce the laws with which the New Mexico Corrections Department (NMCD) is charged..

DEFINITIONS:

Rule: Any rule, regulation, order, standard, statement of policy, including amendments thereto or repeals thereof issued or promulgated by the NMCD, except those relating to the management, confinement, discipline or release of inmates, probationers, parolees and those relating to employees.

POLICY:

- A. No rule shall be effective until approved by the Secretary or a designee.
- B. Unless otherwise provided by law, no rule specifically affecting any person or agency outside the Department shall be adopted, amended or repealed without a public hearing on the proposed action. The public hearing shall be either before the Secretary or a Hearing Officer designated by the Secretary and shall be held in Santa Fe, unless otherwise provided by law.
- C. Notice of the subject matter of the rule, the action proposed to be taken, the time and place of the hearing, the manner in which interested persons may present their views and the method by which copies of the proposed rule, proposed amendment or repeal of an existing rule may be obtained, shall be published at least 30 days prior to the hearing date in a newspaper of general circulation and mailed at least 30 days prior to the hearing date to all persons who have made a written request for advance notice of the hearing.
