Initial Volunteer Training for New Volunteers Only:

For all new volunteers and/or volunteers who haven't attended a volunteer training since January 1, 2016, **must complete an initial volunteer application and submit it at least fourteen (14) days prior to the training date so that it can be approved.** Additionally, you must have received either an email or phone call from Leticia Chavez-Paulette to attend the below trainings. Only those volunteers who have applied and are approved can attend the training and receive an ID card. You can submit completed applications to Leticia.chavez-paul@state.nm.us or fax to 505-383-2826.

Because you are a **NEW** volunteer, it is **HIGHLY** recommended you attend your first-time training at the facility where you will primarily be serving. If that is a great inconvenience or there is not a training date/time available, then sign up for training at the Gara Building.

ID Card Sessions for Renewal Volunteers Only:

For volunteers who have attended a volunteer training since January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2018, you can submit a renewal volunteer application which must be submitted at least fourteen (14) days prior attending the a session listed below to print/reprint their ID cards and you must have received either an email or phone call from Leticia Chavez-Paulette to attend these sessions. Only those volunteers who have completed their renewal packets and are approved can attend the sessions to print/reprint their ID cards.

Additionally, Renewal Volunteer ID cards will only be issued for volunteers whose current ID card was lost, expired, and/or you were never issued one. If your current Volunteer ID card isn't expired, you will not be able to attend these dates and times to receive a new card.
