

How can I make a report?

New Mexico Corrections Department provides several ways to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse or sexual harassment. If you have a family member or friend incarcerated in one of the department facilities, that you believe has suffered from sexual abuse or sexual harassment, you can make a report in the following ways.

- Call the facility, where the inmate is being housed
- Call the NMCD PREA Hotline, 575-523-3303
- Write a letter to the NMCD PREA Coordinator at P.O. Box 639, Las Cruces, New Mexico 88004
- Make a report via email at nmcd-preareporting@state.nm.us

Please provide as much detail as possible

- Inmate's name and NMCD number
- Perpetrator's name (if known)
- Facility where the incident occurred (date, time, location –i.e. cell, showers, chow hall)
- Description of the incident
- Your name, contact number and relationship to the inmate (the report will be investigated, even if you do not provide your name)
